Board members continuously monitor progress towards budget and program goals. The CEO and Resource development team at BBBS assist all the board members in understanding and achieving all responsibilities of membership.

Time Commitment: Minimum requirements are:

- Attend 8 board meetings per year, including the annual board planning retreat
- Join at least one committee and attend committee meetings
- Participate in other events such as fundraisers and mixers
- Board terms are 2 years

Attendance at board, committee meetings and other agency events is a key to success.

Resource Commitment: Board commit to annual fundraising and other resource goals:

- Advocacy and recruitment
- Personal gifts
- Funds raised through fundraising events
- Funds raised from companies
